Tournament parking is available at the locations listed below. Please be sure to check the days, times, and payment options carefully to ensure you utilize the proper lot for the day/s you plan to attend.

There is no public parking at Quail Hollow Club.

LEAVE THE CAR, RIDE THE RAIL

Open **Monday - Sunday**, 5:30 a.m. - 9:00 p.m.

Ticketed patrons for the Wells Fargo Championship can conveniently utilize the CATS LYNX Blue Line to catch tournament shuttles.

- Tournament shuttles will ONLY be available from the Sharon Road West Light Rail Station.
- There will be NO tournament parking at the Sharon Road West Station.
- To access tournament shuttles, all patrons MUST present a valid LYNX ticket purchased on the day of service from one of the LYNX stations OTHER THAN SHARON ROAD WEST. There will be NO exceptions.
- Patrons should exit trains at the station and follow signs to the shuttle loading area. Shuttle drop-off and pick-up will be at the main tournament entrance.

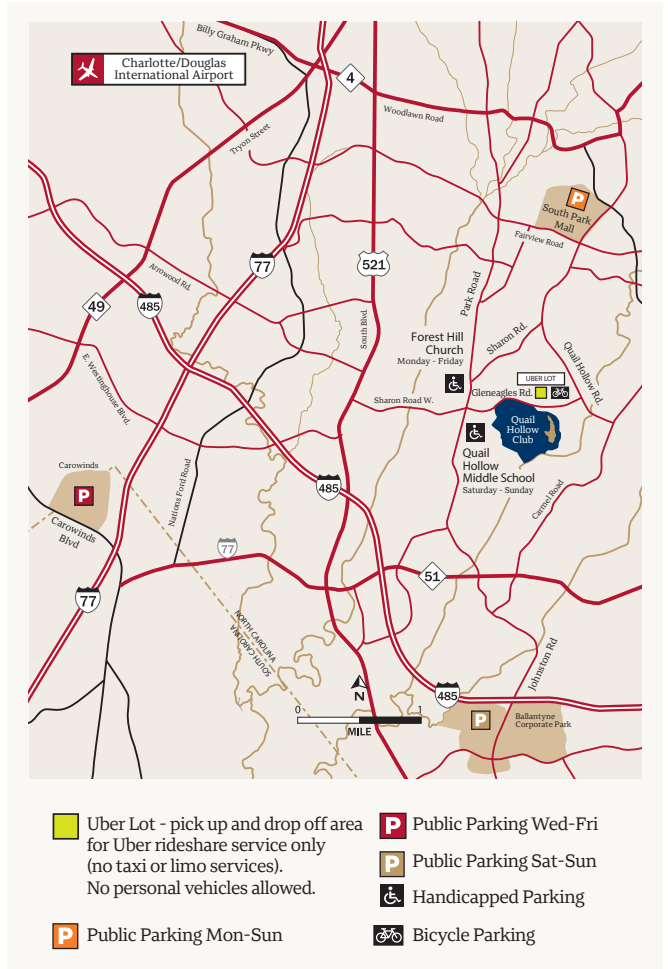

UBER DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP

Uber is the exclusive rideshare partner to help you get to and from the tournament. Patrons can utilize the Uber app to request rides for drop-off and pick-up during the tournament. Uber driver-partners will be able to deliver and pick-up their clients on Gleneagles Rd with close access and patrons can enter the tournament through the main entrance. Personal vehicles will not be allowed to access Gleneagles Rd. All patrons must make their own personal arrangements and be responsible for both their arrival and departure schedules.



HANDICAPPED PARKING

Patrons must apply for access to our Handicapped Parking lot. Please visit WellsFargoChampionship.com/tournament/handicap-parking/ to fill out an application.

Handicapped parking is located at Forest Hill Church, 7224 Park Road, on Mon. - Fri. ONLY and Quail Hollow Middle School, 2901 Smithfield Church Road, on Sat. & Sun. ONLY. Dedicated wheelchair-accessible buses will shuttle disabled persons and their guests to the tournament.

BICYCLE PARKING

The Wells Fargo Championship is a bicycle friendly tournament. Be more environmentally friendly and avoid riding the shuttles. Ride your bicycle to the event! Bike racks will be provided near the main entrance. Please note the tournament is not liable for any stolen or damaged items.

MOBILE DEVICE / CELL PHONE POLICY

- Devices must be on silent at all times; flash may not be used.
- Devices may be used to capture video, audio and photos (content) in all areas throughout tournament week.
- Content may be used for personal purposes (e.g., personal social media); no commercial use.
- No live streaming or real-time coverage (e.g., no shot-by-shot coverage).
- Data use (e.g., texting) is permitted in all areas throughout tournament week.
- Phone calls are allowed only in designated areas.
- Please be respectful of play and do not interfere with players, caddies or media.
- All posted signage and instructions from tournament staff must be observed.
- Failure to comply with this policy may result in the revocation of your ticket.

LOST & FOUND ITEMS

WEATHER

Observe the leaderboards throughout the golf course for "Weather Warning" signs that will appear prior to inclement weather. Spectators are advised to take precautions PRIOR to play being suspended. Avoid the following: tented structures, open areas, hilltops and/or high places, bleachers, isolated trees, golf carts, and wire fences. Please do not presume that play will be canceled if there is a weather event. Re-entry to the tournament will be allowed following a suspension of play.

TICKETS

Please remember that all sales are final, no refunds. All tickets are mobile. Mobile ticket instructions can be found at wellsfargochampionship.com. Children 15 and under are admitted free with a paying adult.

TICKET OFFICE

PROHIBITED ITEMS

- No backpacks, seat cushions, or coolers of any kind
- No opaque bags larger than 6"x6"x6" (in their natural state)
- No clear tote bags, plastic, vinyl, or other carry items larger than 12"x 6"x 12"
- No chair bags (folding chairs are permitted - the sleeves that hold them are not)
- No lawn or oversized chairs
- No pets except for service animals
- No video cameras at any time
- No cameras or Go-Pro's after Wednesday (camera lens must fit within 6"x6" restrictions)
- No selfie sticks
- No computers or laptops
- No whistles, horns or noise makers
- No radios, televisions, or other electronic noise-producing items
- No signs, banners, poles or rods
- No alcoholic beverages may enter or leave the Tournament
- No outside food or beverages may enter the Tournament except for medical or infant needs
- No glass cups or bottles except for medical or infant needs
- No weapons of any kind may enter the tournament including, but not limited to, firearms or knives
- No fireworks or laser pointers
- No illegal substances
- No other items deemed unlawful or dangerous by the PGA TOUR Tournament Security Officials

All items are subject to search. There is no check tent so you will be asked to return all unauthorized items to your car before you are allowed to board shuttles. Tournament is not responsible for personal items left unattended.

AUTOGRAPH POLICY

Autographs will only be permitted in the Autograph Zone Presented by Albermarle for the 2023 Wells Fargo Championship. The Autograph Zone presented by Albermarle will be located behind the Clubhouse near the Main Tournament Putting Green.

SUGGESTED ATTIRE

Appropriate casual golf wear with comfortable walking shoes (soft spikes only). Spectators should have these items on hand: windbreaker, hat/visor, sunscreen, sunglasses and umbrella.
